APPLICATION PROCESS FOR FOREIGN VOLUNTEERS

All foreign nationals who wish to become a volunteer at the Father Ray Foundation must send in an application package that must contain

- Complete the online application form available on our website on the volunteers section
- Your CV/Resume including a recent photo (to check for facial tattoos, piercings etc)
- 2 references, which will be checked
- A preferred date you would like to start (April or October)
- If you are a trained professional and have skills that we require, please contact us so we can discuss the opportunity further.

If you successfully get through this stage, we will then have a Skype interview, this is also your opportunity to ask any questions. A good level of English is required to communicate within the Foundation.

If you are offered a volunteering post at the foundation and would like to accept, we require a Criminal Record Check (CRB or DBS). If you have been living abroad for the past year we then require a Criminal Record Check from that country. We are not able to accept any volunteer who does not provide the Foundation with a Criminal Records Check.

We will not consider an application until we have all the documents listed above. If we feel you are suitable, we will send you more information about being a volunteer. This will include the Volunteer Agreement, Rules & Regulations, advice on getting the correct visa, and additional information that will be useful. We will give you a date you can start, but we do ask that if you are not accepting our offer, you inform us so we can offer the place to someone else.
